


Assembly Instructions

- 1. Print Template at 100% scale on heavy, cardstock paper.
- 2. Use an X-acto knife to cut out all the black rectangles.
- 3. Use an X-acto knife to cut on the dotted black lines.
- 4. Fold funnel tabs towards eachother along the pink lines.
- 5. Pin template to your ironing board.

Use Instructions

- 1. Cut fabric into 1.5" strips.
- 2. With the wrong side facing up, feed the beginning of the strip uder Tab 1 and Tab 2.
- 3. Finger-press the first inch of so of the strip into bias tape by folding both the top and bottom edges towards the center. Fold about 0.25" in, which sill leave a small space between the two edges.
- 4. Contiune to feed the strip under Tab 3, Tab 4, and finally Tab 5.
- 5. Be sure that the fabric is tucked evenly into the two sided of the funnel.
- 6. Pull the fabric out about 6" past the end of the template and press.
- 7. Finally, place your iron at the end of the template and pull the strip through the template and under the iron to make your single-fold bias tape.
- *For double foled bias tape, fold the single-fold bias tape in half lengthwise and press.



Pro Tips

- 1. Place a piece of scrap fabric under your iron to prevent buring your ironing board.
- 2. If the folds aren't holding, try pulling the strip through at a slower pace.
- 3. Use one hand to pull the strip though and the other to make sure the fabric is going through the tunnel correctly.
- 4. Sew all your strips together end-to-end so that you don't have to keep "threading" the template.
